

SUMMARY SHEET - CHARGING REPORT

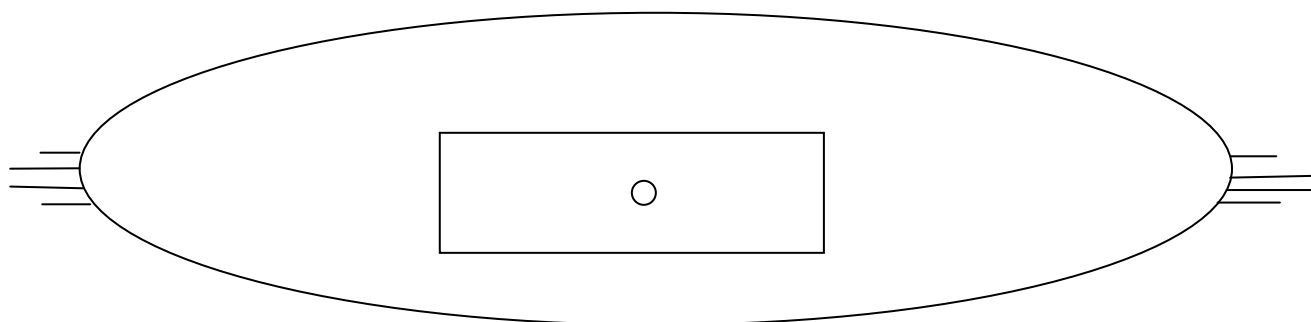
This Summary Sheet has been designed to help reporting umpires prepare for the Tribunal hearing. The Sheet should be filled out on the day of, or the day after the match in which the player was reported, and brought with you to the Tribunal hearing.

You won't be allowed to read straight from the Summary Sheet when giving your evidence at the Tribunal – you will be asked to give oral evidence from what you remember. However, if you get stuck you may be allowed to refer to the Summary Sheet.

On the diagram below, indicate the position of players and the field umpires: also indicate the location of the scoreboard and pavilion/change rooms.



RU = reporting umpire RP = reported player VP – Victim Player
OPs = other players in the area OFUs = other field umpires

Briefly describe **the lead-up play prior** to the reportable incident: eg eg where did ball come from, how did it get there, was there a contest for the ball, etc.

From the umpire's viewpoint, the players were : - side on to each other/ one had his back to the umpire. (delete the one not applicable)

If the latter, which player had his back to the umpire:.....

At the time of the reportable incident

- the reporting umpire was approx.metres from the incident
- how far away (approx) was the ball? metres
- did the 'victim' player have possession of the ball? Yes/No

Describe **the actual contact** by the reported player: eg shoulder and/or hip charge. Where did it make contact with the 'victim' player? How late was the contact? Did reported player jump in order to make contact?

On a scale of 1 – 10, how severe was the contact to the 'victim' player:

(EG. 5 = solid contact which knocked opponent to ground and stunned him, but he was able to take the free kick; 10 = extremely solid 'knockout' contact which forced opponent to leave the ground by stretcher or trainer assistance and player took no further part in the game).

As a result of the contact did the 'victim' player

- go to groundYes/No. If so, for how long.....
- require assistance from trainer...Yes/No If so, for how long.....
- sustain any obvious injury ...Yes/No If so, what injury.....
- leave the ground (eg blood rule) ...Yes/No. If so, for how long?
