

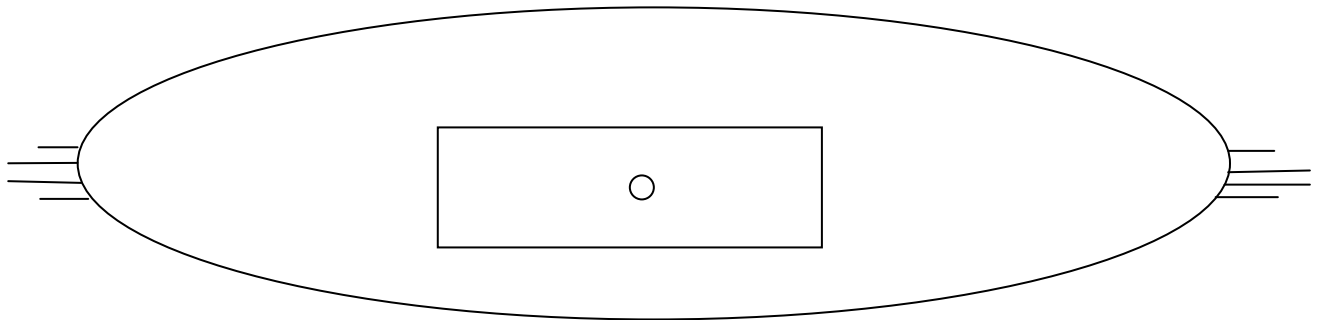
SUMMARY SHEET - ABUSIVE LANGUAGE REPORT

This Summary Sheet has been designed to help reporting umpires prepare for the Tribunal hearing. The Sheet should be filled out on the day of, or the day after the match in which the player was reported, and brought with you to the Tribunal hearing.

You won't be allowed to read straight from the Summary Sheet when giving your evidence at the Tribunal – you will be asked to give oral evidence from what you remember. However, if you get stuck you may be allowed to refer to the Summary Sheet.

Reported player/official: Club:

On the diagram below, indicate the position of players and the field umpires: also indicate the location of the scoreboard and pavilion/change rooms.



RU = reporting umpire
OFUs = other field umpires

RP = reported player/official
SS = nearest spectators

OPs = other players in area

Which quarter was report was made in: 1st quarter/ 2nd/3rd/4th/other (*circle one*)

Briefly describe **the lead-up play prior** to the reportable incident: eg had the reported player been involved in the lead up play, what caused the player/official to abuse the umpire (or another person)?

At the time of the abuse the reporting umpire was approx.metres from the reported player/official.
